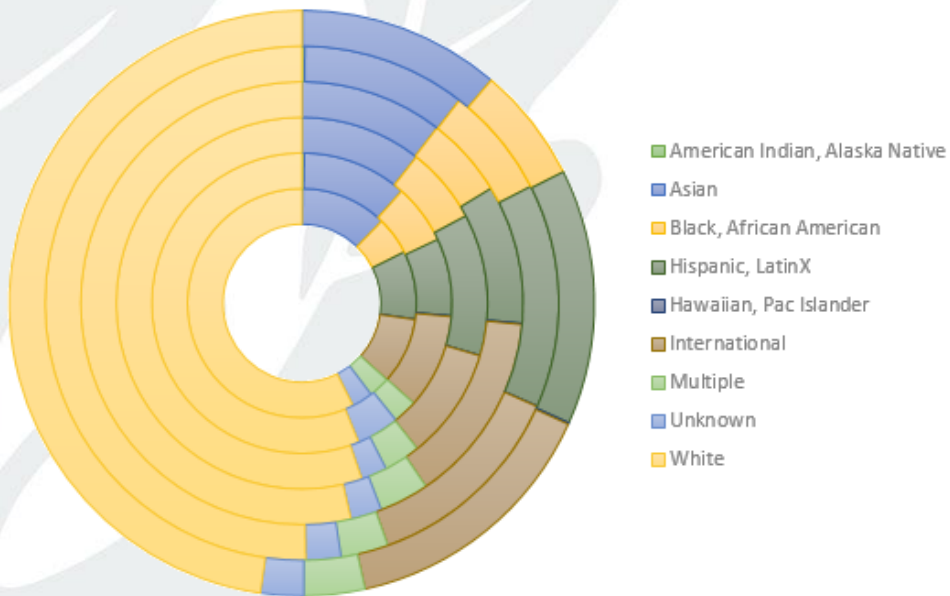

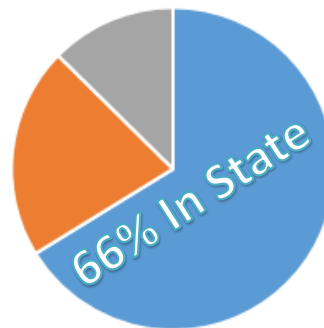
Storrs Freshmen by Ethnicity/Race

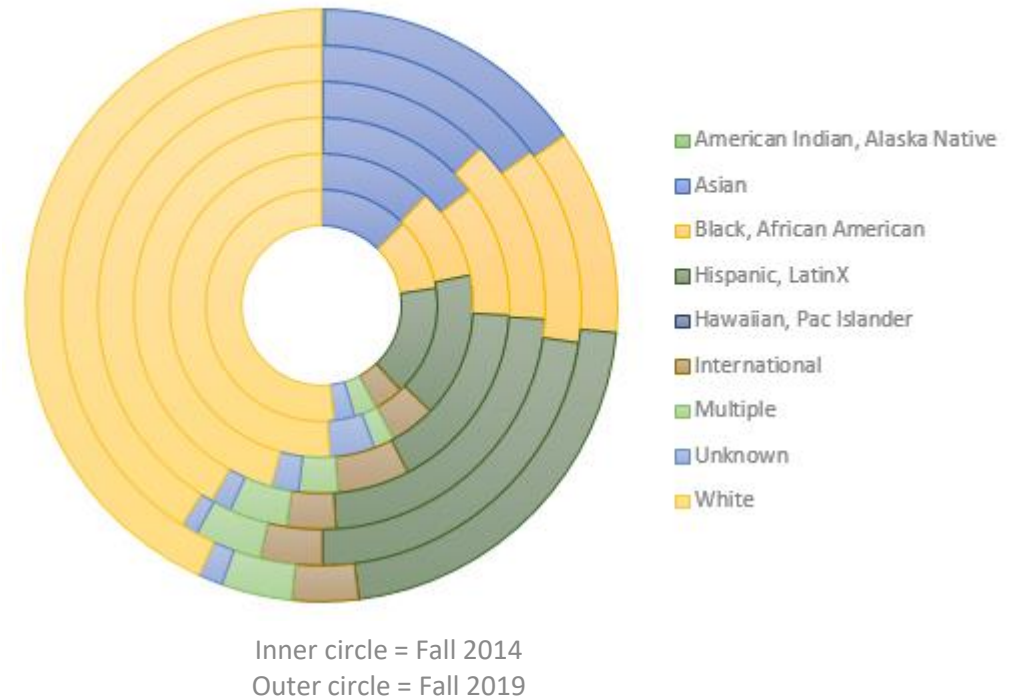
